Despite the rain on Saturday, September 13th, the third annual town-wide Aberdeen Day proved to be a success. The morning began with a fishing contest at Cliffwood Beach, followed by the primary attraction at Matawan Regional High School. The exciting events included: a reptile show, pony rides, a petting zoo, a classic car show, entertainment, crafts, vendor booths, and more. The high school celebration was augmented by a series of events including parking lot events sponsored by DeMarco's Catering & Gourmet Deli and Livoti's Old World Market.
