Mayor Tagliarini called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. and stated that notice of this meeting has been posted and published in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act.

Holly Reycraft went through the Workshop Agenda.

Bond Ordinance Amending bond Ordinance No. 6-2014: Bond Ordinance amends Bond Ordinance No. 6-2014, Sewer Utility, which was adopted on June 17, 2014 to amend purpose from the relocation of the sewer line in conjunction with the reconstruction of Amboy Avenue Bridge (Monmouth County will be paying the costs) to the undertaking of the preliminary engineering and design phase for the Woodfield Sewer Project.

Authorizing the Sale of Property, Brookside Avenue: Ordinance authorizes the sale of property known as Block 347, Lots 28.01, 28.02 and 28.03, Brookside Avenue to the adjacent landowners.

Authorizing the Acquisition of Property, Harrison Avenue: Ordinance authorizes the acquisition of property known as Block 259, Lot 2, 12 Harrison Avenue.

Shared Services Agreement with Matawan-Aberdeen Regional School Board of Education: Resolution authorizes Shared Services Agreement with aforementioned for the use of school buses for Summer Adventures Program.

Accepting Grant from Hazardous Discharge Site Remediation Fund Public Entity Program: Resolution accepts aforementioned grant through the Department of Environmental Protection and the New Jersey Economic Development Authority for

Remedial Investigation of South River Metal Products Site Property in the amount of \$274,248.

Discussion: Increase of Certificate of Continued Occupancy (CCO) Fees for Businesses:

John Quinn, Director of Planning, Zoning and Development submitted a memo to the Township Council regarding increasing fees for the Certificate of Continued Occupancy for businesses and the fees that surrounding towns are charging.

Mayor Tagliarini stated the increase will put us in line with the surrounding towns.

Holly Reycraft stated an ordinance will be needed to amend our fee schedule.

Council did not have any questions on the workshop items.

Councilwoman Montone made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Councilman Martucci and unanimously concurred by Council.
