

**ABERDEEN TOWNSHIP COUNCIL WORKSHOP MEETING
TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 15, 2015**

Mayor Tagliarini called the meeting to order at 8:30 p.m. and stated that notice of this meeting has been posted and published in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act.

Holly Reycraft went through the Workshop Agenda.

Pawnbroker, Dealers in Precious Metals and Gems Ordinance: Request was made by the Police Department to assist law enforcement officials and victims of crime in recovering stolen precious metals and other second hand goods that might go to a pawn shop.

Ron Gordon stated this is part of a county wide effort by the Monmouth County Prosecutors Office to make this uniformed throughout the county and clean up businesses that has issues.

Bid for One New 4 Wheeled Pavement Profiler: Bids were received by the Township Manager on August 25, 2015 for aforementioned project. Binder Machinery Co. of South Plainfield was the lone responsive and responsible bidder with a total amount of \$252,500.00.

Councilman Cannon asked how much the trailer will costs that this milling machine will go on.

Holly Reycraft stated she is getting prices now. We can still use it.

Councilman Cannon asked what if the trailer costs \$70,000. How are we going to move it?

Holly Reycraft stated we do have a trailer it can be moved on.

Councilman Cannon asked why we are buying a new trailer.

Holly Reycraft stated the one we have is okay to use, it is not the best trailer for the milling machine.

Mayor Tagliarini stated he would like to table this resolution until we find out about the trailer.

Bid for Two Steel Dump Bodies: Bids were received by the Township Manager on August 25, 2015 for aforementioned project. Cliffside Body Corp of Fairview, NJ was the lowest responsive bidder but failed to meet the technical specifications. Tony Sanchez of Ledgewood, NJ was the second lowest responsive and responsible bidder and met the technical specifications.

Bid for Department of Public Works materials for Maintenance and Repairs: Bids were received by the Township Manager on September 4, 2015 for aforementioned project. HD Water Works Supply of Edison, NJ was the lone responsive and responsible bidder.

Bid for Department of Public Works Road Materials for Maintenance and Repairs: Bids were received by the Township Manager on September 4, 2015 for aforementioned project. Stavola Construction Materials Inc. of Tinton Falls, NJ was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for items 1-3,5,6,5A and 6A. Trap Rock Industries of Kingston, NJ was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for items 4 and 4A. No bids were submitted for items 7 and 7A.

Renewal of Liquor Licenses: Liquor License renewals for the 2015/2016 period. All fees have been received and Tax Clearance Certificates have been issued.

Agreement between Township and Aberdeen Enviro, LLC for Remediation within Redevelopment Area: Authorizing Mayor to execute Remediation Agreement with Aberdeen Enviro, LLC, a subsidiary of RPM Development, LLC for remediation of South River Metals.

Discussion: Climate Change Resolution: Councilman Cannon stated we were asked to pass a resolution that was passed in a number of towns in New Jersey. Councilman Cannon noted the resolution passed by Belmar, which had a good amount of damage from Hurricane Sandy. Information will be forwarded to Environmental Board for their recommendation.

Council did not have any questions on the workshop items.

Councilwoman Montone made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Councilman Swindle

and unanimously concurred by Council.
