Renewal in Central Jersey Health Insurance Fund: Resolution renews membership in the Central Jersey Health Insurance Fund which is the provider for our healthcare for the period of January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2018. Our Risk Manager has research health insurance fund and our was still the most cost effective.

Insertion of Item of Revenue in the 2015 Budget: Resolution requests the Director of Division of Local Government Services to add an item of revenue, Division of Highway Traffic Safety Drive Sober or Get Pulled over for \$5,000.00 in the 2015 Budget.

Renewal of Liquor License for 2015/2016: Renews Remvac/Moores Liquor License, which is a pocket license that received Special Ruling from the State.

Discussion: Stone Road Meadows Preservation Effort: Fran Donnelly and Bill Shaw, Hazlet, New Jersey gave a brief presentation on Stone Road Meadows Preservation. 30 acres on Route 36 bordering Union Beach. This property could be a magnet to bring homes and businesses to the area if this area is preserved. Really looking to be a County Park, a park with trails. Support Resolutions came from Keyport, Keansburg, Union Beach, Hazlet, Monmouth County Freeholders and Parks Commission. The Council will consider doing a resolution in support.
