Pilot Agreement between Township of Aberdeen and Glassworks Urban Renewal, LLC: Ordinance approves and authorizes financial agreement with Glassworks Urban Renewal, LLC for property at Block 155, Lot 1 located in the Glassworks Redevelopment Area.

Bid for DPW Electrical Maintenance: Bids were received by the Qualified Purchasing Agent on June 28, 2016 for aforementioned project. Quality Electrical Construction Co. of West Keansburg, NJ was the lone responsible bidder.

Bid for DPW Routine and Emergency Repair: Bids were received by the Qualified Purchasing Agent on June 28, 2016 for aforementioned project. B&W Construction of South River, NJ was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.

Liquor License Renewal 2016/2017: Renewal for Liquor License Remvac Stores Inc. which is a pocket license and has received special ruling for the 2016/2017 period.

Engineering Services for Bid Specifications for Solid Waste and Recycling Collection and Disposal Services: Michael McClelland, CME Associates submitted a proposal on May 24, 2016 for aforementioned engineering services for an amount not to exceed \$15,000.00.

Holly Reycraft stated Tim Gillen met with Catherine Morello, Recycling Coordinator regarding the bid specs for the recycling services. We are also getting input from the Environmental Board.

Councilman Cannon suggested the Council have a committee due to a quality of life issue with garbage and recycling.

Engineering Services for NJDOT 2016 Safe Routes to School Program: Donald Norbut, T&M Associates submitted a proposal on May 12, 2016 for aforementioned engineering services for an amount not to exceed \$6,400.00.
