Adopting Redevelopment Plan: Ordinance adopting the redevelopment plan relating to the property at 1337, 1341-1343 and 1355 Route 34, known as Block 114, Lots 6, 7.01, 13 and 13 Q-Farm in the Township.

Authorizing Transfer/Donation of 1989 Utility Truck: United States Department of Defense, Defense Logistics Agency established a RTD Program to redistribute goods to federal, state and local government. The Township Police Department has been authorized to participate in the program and acquired a 1989 Utility Truck Humvee for law enforcement activities.

2014 Appointments to Environmental and Shade Tree Advisory Board: The members of the Environmental and Shade Tree Advisory Board will be appointed for one year term to expire on January 31, 2015.

Authorizing Agreement with CME Associates for Engineering Services associated with Superstorm Sandy ADA Accessible Seawall Project and Existing Sand Dunes: Tim Gillen, CME Associates submitted a proposal dated October 14, 2013 for aforementioned project for a total amount of \$105,122.00.

Authorizing Agreement with Monmouth County Board of Chosen Freeholders for SCAT program: In a letter dated November 1, 2013, Monmouth County Division of Transportation submitted an agreement for 2014 Special Citizens Area Transportation System.

Relay for Life: Eric Freedman made a brief presentation to the Council regarding the Relay for Life event that will be held at the High School this year on Friday, June 13, 2014. Last year's event was a huge success and Mr. Freedman is hoping for another successful event.

Council did not have any questions on the workshop items.
