BOND ORDINANCE NO. 13-2014 – INTRODUCTION

Deputy Mayor Montone made a motion to introduce Bond Ordinance No. 13-2014 on first reading by title and to order the same to be published by summary in the August 28, 2014 issue of the Asbury Park Press, together with notice of its introduction and passage on first reading by title, and that it will be further considered for final passage after a public hearing at a meeting of the Township Council to be held on September 4, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. in the Municipal Building of the Township of Aberdeen at One Aberdeen Square. The Clerk read Bond Ordinance No. 13-2014 – BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAKING OF VARIOUS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS IN, BY AND FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF ABERDEEN, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$550,000 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO APPROPRIATE INSURANCE PROCEEDS, TO MAKE A DOWN PAYMENT, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS.
