

**ABERDEEN TOWNSHIP COUNCIL WORKSHOP MEETING

Mayor Tagliarini called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and stated that notice of this meeting has been posted and published in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act.

Holly Reycraft went through the Workshop Agenda.

Ordinances – Sewer User Charges and Water and Sewer Connection Fees: Upon the recommendation of the Township Auditor, proposed ordinances will change annual sewer use fee to \$672.00 per EDCU, increase the Water Connection Fees from \$2,898.00 to \$3,126.00 and the Sewer Connection Fees from \$3,946.00 to \$5,064.00.

Authorized Representative to Represent Township to New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Loan: The Township intends to file an application with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Trust for the Woodfield Area Sanitary Sewer and Force Main Installation project. Holly Reycraft, Township Manager will be appointed as Authorized Representative to represent the Township.

Bid for Odor & Corrosion Control – Bioxide Chemicals: Bids were received by the Township Manager on September 9, 2014 for aforementioned project. Siemens Water Technologies of Sarasota Florida was the lowest responsible bidder and be awarded contract.

Relief from Property Taxes for Non-Profit Corporation: Eihab Human Services, Inc., a Domestic Non-Profit Corporation who's purposed is education, Adult and Senior care, Children Services and Mental Retardation has requested relief from property taxes for

370 Fairfield Way and 60 Oxford Lane in the Township of Aberdeen.

Presentation: Community Forestry Management Plan: moved to the regular meeting.

Council did not have any questions on the workshop items.

Councilman Brenner made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Councilman Cannon and unanimously concurred by Council.
