Mayor Tagliarini called the meeting to order at 7:35 p.m. and stated that notice of this meeting has been posted and published in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act.

Holly Reycraft went through the Workshop Agenda.

Bid for Department of Public Works Materials for Maintenance and Repair: Bids were received by the Township Manager on September 16, 2014 for aforementioned project. HD Water Works Supply of Edison, NJ was the lone responsible bidder to be awarded contract.

Enabling Resolution for Green Acres Program – Freneau Lands Acquisition: Enabling Resolution for Department of Environmental Protection Green Acres Program #1301-10-037 Freneau Lands Acquisitions Grant in the amount of \$325,000 to purchase following parcels: Block 124, Lots 1 & 2; Block 149, Lot ; Block 151, Lots 1-4; Block 127, Lots 1-12, Block 128, Lots 1-9 and Block 129, Lots 2-12 located on Greenwood Road along the Matawan Creek, Wilson Avenue and New Brunswick Avenue.

Memorandum of Understanding between the Township of Aberdeen and Administrative Officers Association, Superior Officers Association and Police Benevolent Association Local 163: Memorandum of Understanding extends aforementioned contracts through December 31, 2019.

Discussion: Garage Sales in the Township of Aberdeen: Mayor Tagliarini stated it is getting popular that towns or residents are running facebook type of garage sales. Some townships are already doing this. Looking to see if our residents could benefit from
