

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-75

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ABERDEEN, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH,
STATE OF NEW JERSEY, FIXING THE DELINQUENT DATE FOR THE LATE
PAYMENT OF TAXES FOR THE SECOND QUARTER OF 2020**

WHEREAS, the Township of Aberdeen adopted Resolution #2020-73 on April 16th 2020 setting the rate of interest on delinquent taxes and utility charges unpaid after May 1st 2020 at a rate of 0% on the first \$1,500.00 of delinquency and 0% per annum on any amount of taxes in excess of \$1,500.00 effective as of May 1, 2020 through June 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Governor Murphy issued Executive Order 130 on April 29th, 2020 stating that no municipality shall pass a resolution to temporarily fix, reduce, or retroactively modify the rate of interest charged for failure to make timely payment; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 130 also allows for an extension of the grace period due to the financial impact on the tax payers of New Jersey due to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A.54:4-67 permits the governing body of a municipality to allow for a 10 day grace period for quarterly tax payments and a 30 day billing period for quarterly utility payments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council, Township of Aberdeen, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey as follows;

The Tax Collector is hereby authorized and directed to extend the second quarter 2020 grace period to June 1, 2020 at which time interest will be imposed on any payment received after this date retroactively to May 1, 2020 for late payment of the second quarter 2020 taxes and utility installments, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 54:4-64, N.J.S.A. 54:4-67 and Executive Order 130.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 2020-73 is hereby rescinded.
