

**RESOLUTION NO. 2021-103**

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ABERDEEN, COUNTY OF  
MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, FIXING THE DELINQUENT DATE  
FOR THE LATE PAYMENT OF TAXES AND UTILITIES FOR THE THIRD  
QUARTER OF 2021**

**WHEREAS**, the delinquent date for the payment of taxes and utilities for the third quarter of 2021 allows a 10 day grace period and requires the imposition of interest on delinquent payments received after August 10<sup>th</sup>, 2021, which is charged retroactively to August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021: and

**WHEREAS**, the mailing of tax and utility bills has been delayed for 2021 and taxpayers would have inadequate time to faithfully remit payment with the ten-day grace period, imposing a hardship on the taxpayers.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Council of the Township of Aberdeen, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that in accordance with N.J.S.A. 54:4-64, the Tax Collector is hereby authorized and directed to extend the third quarter grace period until September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021, at which time interest will be imposed retroactively to August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021, for late payments of the third quarter tax and utility installments, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 54:4-64.
