

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-129

WHEREAS, pursuant to provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq., bid specifications were prepared and duly advertised by the Township of Aberdeen for Real Property Data Collection and Verification Services; and

WHEREAS, bids were received by the Township's Qualified Purchasing Agent on April 22, 2021 for the services; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 2021-79, the Township awarded a three-year contract to Realty Data Systems of Lincroft, New Jersey as the lowest, responsible bidder with a first-year price of \$63,297 in accordance with its bid; and

WHEREAS, Realty Data Systems has informed the Township that it will perform more property inspections in the first year of the contract than anticipated in its bid, which will result in an increase in compensation to \$66,662 for the additional inspections and cost of mailing the first set of notices to property owners that is the Township's responsibility pursuant to the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to authorize an increase in compensation of \$3,365 for contractual services performed in the first year of the contract that will necessitate fewer inspections to be performed in the final two years of the contract and reduce the costs for those two years; and

WHEREAS, the authorization of additional compensation for the first year of the contract is necessary the Township's continued efficient operation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Aberdeen that it hereby authorizes an increase in compensation for the performance of Real Property Data Collection and Verification Services by Realty Data Systems in the amount of \$3,365 for a total first-year contract cost of \$66,662.
