A RESOLUTION APPROVING PARTICIPATION WITH THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY
FEDERAL GRANT PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF
LAW AND PUBLIC SAFETY, OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL

WHEREAS, the Township of Aberdeen is authorized to accept funding of approximately \$32,400 with a match of \$569,266.48 for an approximate project total cost of \$601,666.48 for a project under the State of New Jersey Safe and Secure Communities Grant Program (Subaward Number 22-1330 for the Subaward Period of August 4, 2021 to August 3, 2022); and

WHEREAS, the Aberdeen Township Council has reviewed the accompanying application and has approved said request; and

WHEREAS, the project is a joint effort between the New Jersey Department of Law and Public Safety, Office of the Attorney General and the Township of Aberdeen, for the purpose described in the application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Aberdeen that:

1. As a matter of public policy the Township of Aberdeen wishes to accept participation to the fullest extent possible with the NJ Department of Law and Public Safety, Office of the Attorney General.
2. The NJ Department of Law and Public Safety, Office of the Attorney General will receive funds on behalf of the Applicant.
3. The NJ Department of Law and Public Safety, Office of the Attorney General shall be responsible for the receipt and review of the applications for said funds.
4. The NJ Department of Law and Public Safety, Office of the Attorney General shall initiate allocations to the applicant as authorized.
