

**RESOLUTION 2022-97**

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ABERDEEN, IN THE COUNTY OF  
MONMOUTH AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING NEW JERSEY  
JCP&L TO NOTIFY THE TOWNSHIP OF RESIDENTIAL  
CUSTOMERS DISCONNECTED INVOLUNTARILY FROM ELECTRIC SERVICE**

**WHEREAS**, by way of letter dated July 29, 2022, Jersey City Power & Light (JCP&L), notified the Township that it may choose to receive a daily notification list from JCP&L of Township residential customers who have been disconnected involuntarily from electric service; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Council finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of Township residents for the Township to receive such notifications.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Township Council of the Township of Aberdeen, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

The Township Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to forward a copy of this resolution, along with the name and contact information for the municipal agent designated to receive notifications, to Kristin Wisinieski, First Energy Corp, Revenue Assurance Department, PO Box 367, Holmdel, NJ 07733, per correspondence dated July 29, 2022, attached hereto.
2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
