

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-144

WHEREAS, the Assessor of the Township of Aberdeen has submitted a request for the exemption of residential property taxes for the owners of 5 Bechstein Drive, Aberdeen, also known as Block 36 Lot 23 on the official map of the Township of Aberdeen, for relief from all property taxes as of January 1, 2023; **and**

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.6 the State of New Jersey provides an exemption from residential taxes for all property owned and used by any Non-Profit Corporation in connection with its curriculum, work, care, treatment and study of men, women, or children with intellectual disabilities; **and**

WHEREAS, such information has been submitted to the Assessor on behalf of The New Jersey Institute for Disabilities, Inc., who were declared to be a Domestic Non-Profit Corporation in accordance with New Jersey law on September 1, 1977, and whose purpose of the Non Profit is religious, charitable and educational;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Aberdeen, in the County of Monmouth and the State of New Jersey, that relief from payment of property taxes as of January 1, 2023 is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Township Council hereby endorses the requested exemption form for residential property Block 36 Lot 23 for as long as The New Jersey Institute for Disabilities, Inc. remains eligible for this exception pursuant to N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.6.
