The Aberdeen Township Police made the following arrests July 4, 2018 through July 10, 2018:

- An 18-year-old man and a 17-year-old youth, both from Staten Island, were charged with possession of marijuana following a motor vehicle stop on Hwy. 35 on July 4. P.O. Edgar Serrano was the arresting officer.
