

**RESOLUTION NO. 2023-62**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Aberdeen Police Department is in need of professional consultation and a comprehensive plan to reorganize the Aberdeen Police Department's Property and Evidence Vault to meet the standards of the Attorney General, as well as best practices that are aligned with the standards of a New Jersey State Association of Chiefs of Police (NJSACOP) Accredited Agency; and

**WHEREAS**, Roberts & Associates submitted a proposal dated October 28, 2022 for the provision of consulting services for the Aberdeen Police Department regarding their Property and Evidence Function ("Services"); and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Council of the Township of Aberdeen that the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to execute an agreement with Roberts & Associates in accordance with the proposal dated October 28, 2022, attached hereto and made part of this resolution. The total sum of this agreement is not to exceed \$17,795.

This agreement is made without competitive bidding as a "professional service" under the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)a(I).

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution is subject to the certification of availability of Township of Aberdeen funds.
