The Aberdeen Township Police made the following arrests December 20, 2017 through January 2, 2018:

- Peter J. Martin, 54, Aberdeen, was charged with driving while intoxicated, careless driving, leaving the scene of an accident, and failure to report an accident following a motor vehicle crash on Idlewild Lane on December 23. P.O. Raymond Campbell was the arresting officer with assistance from P.O. John Zeller.
- Frederick A. Caruso, 52, Manalapan, was charged with driving while intoxicated, reckless driving, refusal to submit to a breath test, and other motor vehicle violations following a motor vehicle stop on Lloyd Rd. on December 24. P.O. Ronald Osadacz was the arresting officer.

- On December 30 P.O.s Martin Walsh and Jessica McDougall responded to an overdose in a restroom at the Shop Rite store on Lloyd Rd. Officers administered two doses of Narcan and were able to revive the 45-year-old male victim, who was subsequently transported to Bayshore Community Hospital.

Officers responded to or initiated 518 calls for service between December 20, 2017 and January 2, 2018, including 29 suspicious persons/vehicles; 46 alarms; 44 first aid calls; nine domestic violence incidents, nine noise complaints, five disorderly persons, 15 motor vehicle crashes, one theft, three frauds, five welfare checks, eight crisis intervention calls, and 110 motor vehicle stops. Officers issued 125 motor vehicle summonses.
