

**A RESOLUTUION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ABERDEEN
AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWNSHIP OF ABERDEEN
AND MATAWAN-ABERDEEN REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT REGARDING
REMITTANCE OF TAX COLLECTIONS**

WHEREAS, the Township of Aberdeen, is a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey, governed under the Faulkner Act N.J.S.A. 40:69A-1, et seq., and are authorized under New Jersey law to enter into such agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Matawan Aberdeen Regional School District is a local public school district organized and operated pursuant to Title 18A of the New Jersey Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the District serves school-age children residing in the Township of Aberdeen (“the Township”) and the Borough of Matawan; and

WHEREAS, New Jersey Statutes, including but not necessarily limited to N.J.S.A. 54:4-75, 76, and judicial decisions, including but not necessarily limited to *Board of Education v. Fair Lawn*, 143 N.J. Super. 259 (Law Div. 1976), *aff’d*, 153 N.J. Super. 480 (App. Div. 1977), prescribe the Township’s legal obligations regarding transmission of tax collections from the Township to the District; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to memorialize their understanding with respect to a mutually acceptable schedule for transmission of said tax collections from the Township to the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Township Council as follows:

1. The above recitals are herby incorporated into the body of this resolution as if set forth at length herein.
2. The Mayor and Clerk are herby authorized to execute a Agreement in a form substantially similar to that which is annexed hereto as EXHIBIT A.
3. The Agreement, which shall take effect upon full execution by the Matawan-Aberdeen Regional School District, shall be open to public inspection in the Clerk’s office.
