

BOND ORDINANCE NO. 23-2018

BOND ORDINANCE REAPPROPRIATING \$26,073.18 PROCEEDS OF OBLIGATIONS NOT NEEDED FOR THEIR ORIGINAL PURPOSES AND AMENDING BOND ORDINANCES PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR THE ACQUISITION OF NEW COMMUNICATION AND SIGNAL SYSTEMS EQUIPMENT IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF ABERDEEN, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ABERDEEN, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:2-39, it is hereby determined that \$26,073.13 of the proceeds of obligations originally made available pursuant to the following sections of the bond ordinances listed below of the Township of Aberdeen, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey (the "Township") are no longer necessary for the various purposes for which the obligations previously were authorized:

Section 2. The \$26,073.18 proceeds described in Section 1 and made available pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:2-39 are hereby reappropriated to provide for the acquisition of new communication and signal systems equipment, consisting of radio communication system upgrade equipment for the use of the Police Department.

Section 3. The bond ordinances referred to in Section 1 of this bond ordinance are hereby amended to change the descriptions to conform to the purpose described in Section 2 of this bond

ordinance. No changes to the useful lives were made to the bond ordinances referred to in Section 1 of this bond ordinance.

Section 4. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this bond ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 5. This bond ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
