

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-83

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ABERDEEN, COUNTY OF
MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, FIXING THE DELINQUENT DATE
FOR THE LATE PAYMENT OF TAXES FOR THE THIRD QUARTER OF
2017**

WHEREAS, the delinquent date for the payment of taxes for the third quarter of 2017 allows a 10 day grace period and requires the imposition of interest on delinquent payments received after August 10th, 2017, which is charged retroactively to August 1st, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the mailing of tax bills has been delayed for 2017 and taxpayers would have inadequate time to faithfully remit payment with the ten-day grace period, imposing a hardship on the taxpayers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Aberdeen, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that in accordance with N.J.S.A. 54:4-64, the Tax Collector is hereby authorized and directed to extend the third quarter grace period until August 22nd, 2017, at which time interest will be imposed retroactively to August 1st, 2017, for late payments of the third quarter taxes, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 54:4-64.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Monmouth County Finance Department and the Matawan Aberdeen Regional School District.
