

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-85

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SHARED SERVICES
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWNSHIP OF ABERDEEN AND
THE TOWNSHIP OF MARLBORO FOR ROAD AND DRAINAGE
IMPROVEMENTS**

WHEREAS, the Township of Aberdeen with offices located at 1 Aberdeen Square Aberdeen, NJ 07747 (hereinafter referred to as "Aberdeen") and the Township of Marlboro with offices located at 1979 Township Drive Marlboro, NJ 07746 (hereinafter referred to as "Marlboro") seek to provide for the most efficient and effective method of providing for road and drainage improvements to Woodbrook Drive; and

WHEREAS, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, et seq., (the "Act") permits units of local government to share services for particular purposes and to effectuate agreements for any service or circumstance that will aid and encourage a reduction of local expenses; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Aberdeen and the Township of Marlboro are local units of the State of New Jersey and are authorized under New Jersey law to enter into a Shared Services Agreement pursuant to the Act; and

WHEREAS, Aberdeen and Marlboro desire to enter into a shared services agreement for road and drainage improvements to Woodbrook Drive; and

WHEREAS, representatives of Aberdeen and Marlboro have negotiated a Shared Services Agreement, a copy of which is annexed hereto as **EXHIBIT A**, and the terms of which are incorporated into this resolution as if set forth at length herein; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Township of Aberdeen has determined that the entry into the Shared Services Agreement is in the best interest of the residents and taxpayers of the Township of Aberdeen,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ABERDEEN, that the Mayor is authorized pursuant to and in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq., to enter into the Shared Services Agreement with the Township of Marlboro for road and drainage improvements to Woodbrook Drive substantially in the form annexed hereto and which may only be modified upon advice of counsel that such modifications are consistent with the intent and terms of the annexed Agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of the Shared Services Agreement, when fully executed, be filed with the Division of Local Government Services in the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, for informational purposes, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:65-4(b).
